Subject: English

- 1. Alphabet Adventure
- Make a colourful A to Z word book.
- Write one word for each letter (e.g., A Apple, B -Ball...)
- Draw or paste pictures for each word.
 - Try to choose new or interesting words!

2. My Family Tree

- · Draw a picture of your family tree.
- Write names like this:
 This is my mother. Her name is Rina.

This is my grandfather. His name is Raj.

3. Poem Time!

- Learn any short English poem (Parent can help choose).
- Write it down neatly.
- Draw a picture about the poem.
 - Practice reciting it with expression and actions!

4. My Day - Picture Diary (3 Days)

- For 3 days, draw what you did in the morning, afternoon, and evening.
- Write 1 sentence for each time.
 Morning: I brushed my teeth.

- Afternoon: I ate lunch with mummy.
- Evening: I read a storybook.

5. Word Jar

- Make a "Word Jar" using a small jar or box.
- Every day, write 1 new English word on a chit and put it in.
- At the end of the holidays, try using some of them in a sentence!

Focus Areas: Letter Sounds, Blends & Digraphs

Activities to Complete:

- 1. Sound Hunt Around the House
- Pick 5 beginning sounds (like b, t, m, s, l).
- Walk around your house and find one thing for each sound.
- Write the word and draw it.
 b ball, m mat, etc.

Record and Read!

Choose a short phonics-rich story or rhyme.

- Read it aloud and record yourself.
- Listen back and try again to improve!
